

Boralex announces the commissioning of 32 MW in France

Montréal (Québec), December 20, 2013 – Boralex Inc. (“Boralex” or the “Corporation”) announces that its subsidiary, Boralex Europe S.A., proceeded to the commercial commissioning of La Vallée, a 32 MW wind farm. A first part of 18 MW was commissioned at the beginning of December while a second part of 14 MW will be commissioned by the end of December.

“The commissioning of La Vallée wind farm, pursuant to the schedule, demonstrates the thoroughness of Boralex’s team as well as the strength of the market in France for renewable energy” said Patrick Lemaire, President and CEO.
