

Boralex Selected by the Innu Nation as a Partner to Develop a 200 MW Wind Farm Project on Quebec's Côte-Nord

Montreal, Quebec, September 8, 2016 - Boralex Inc. ("Boralex") (TSX:BLX) is pleased to announce it has been selected by the Innu Nation as a partner to develop the 200 MW Apuiat wind farm project located on public land in the municipality of Port-Cartier in Quebec's Côte-Nord region. In the coming weeks, the Innu Nation, Boralex and RES will continue the information process and intent to begin public consultations in mid-October. These consultations, prior to the start, will improve the project by increasing the knowledge of the region and its use and taking into account feedback from stakeholders at an early stage of development.
