

## **Boralex: winner of *Business of the Year* prize at the Québec's Wind Power Industry Gala**

Montréal (Québec), June 11, 2014 – The 4<sup>th</sup> Québec Wind Industry Gala, organized by the TechnoCentre éolien in Gaspé (Québec, Canada) on June 10, awarded Boralex Inc. ("Boralex" or the "Corporation") as *Business of the Year*.
